Foolish Virgins Part 1 – The Foolish Virgin Class Lives Eternally

In this writing we want to discuss who the foolish virgin class is. Is there a foolish virgin class? Do they have eternal life? If so, when do they recognize it? We will answer these questions in this writing.

First, let's look at where the foolish virgins show up in the scripture.

Now, let's look at what the prophet of the hour said about them.

Now, there was the virgins went out to meet Him. And the foolish virgins, now, did not have Oil in their lamp, but they had everything else: they were clean; they believed in Christ; they preached the Word that they believed, their denomination would let them preach; they preached that, the second coming, the Sacrifice, the Atonement. They believe.

It is the second resurrection wherein the five foolish virgins come up. Notice that they were virgins.

They did not have the Holy Spirit so they missed being in the bride, while the five wise who had oil

became a part of that bride. But these people, being a separated, God-loving people, and trying to abide
in the Word, according to what they knew of it, and being a help in the work of the Lord will come up at
the end of time. They will miss the millennium, which you can begin to see by these truths is much more
important and wonderful than we have ever thought or believed.

Both scripture and Brother Branham declares there is a foolish virgin class. They are virgins without the Holy Spirit. They miss being in the bride because they are void of the Holy Spirit. However, they are virgins. Now, let's find out if they have eternal life and when they recognize it. Let's look at a scripture and quote.

Now let us go another step, but before we do let us review our case thus far. First of all we know most assuredly that the purpose of God stands in election. It was purposed in Himself. It was God's purpose to bring forth a people like unto Himself that would be a Word Bride. She was chosen before the foundation of the world IN HIM. She was fore-known and beloved before she was ever brought forth during the ages upon the earth. She was redeemed by His blood and can NEVER come into condemnation. I presume that they are asking the question, "the five virgins," the five wise and the five foolish. Now, if you were with us in the last teachings in Revelation, you find out there that those virgins, the--the five foolish virgins were not lost; but they were not permitted to go into the wedding supper, but they suffered persecution, and was martyred, and raised again at the general resurrection in the last day. Those are the people where He separated the sheep from the goats (See?); they stood before judgment.
